

# Invitation to Tender

*Location: Limes Cottage, Little Missenden*

*Works: Willow Coppicing*

The site is on the eastern edge of Little Missenden, Amersham, Bucks (HP7 0RG).

The River Misbourne runs through the middle of an area of wet pasture and willow.



## Schedule of works

### Willow Coppicing

- An area of 1,700m<sup>2</sup> (shown on the site plan below) area has willow regrowth from brush piles left 2 years previously (shown in photograph above).
- All the recent ground-level sprouting should be removed and regrowth prevented (through pulling roots).
- Brash should be chipped and left in piles on-site.
- There is Himalayan Balsam on site, so care must be taken not to spread this within or off the site.

## Evaluation process

Tenders will be evaluated on the basis of the following details:

- Demonstrated understanding of the project brief.
- Demonstrated relevant qualifications, knowledge and experience.
- Description of how the work will be carried out.
- Estimated time required to deliver the survey and report.

- Details of your health and safety procedures.
